Re: Migration to ISO 9001:2008 – Quickly Coming to an End!

As you know, since 2009/11/15 any new certificates issued for ISO 9001 certification had to refer to the new standard, ISO 9001:2008. Refer to ANAB Heads Up issues 129, 135, and 155.

ANAB has discovered several cases of certificates that were issued after 2009/11/15 that still refer to ISO 9001:2000. This is not accurate and the validity of those certificates is in question. Those certificates must be withdrawn or revised to read ISO 9001:2008 (if the appropriate audit to ISO 9001:2008 took place). ANAB asks that you review your ISO 9001 certificates immediately and make sure they refer to the appropriate standard.

Any certificate to ISO 9001:2000 after 2010/11/15 will be invalid.

If ANAB finds such certificates still in the marketplace we will issue major NCRs.
