Re: Accreditation Program for FSSC 22000 Management Systems

ANAB is pleased to announce accreditation of certification bodies for the GFSI- benchmarked food safety management system certification scheme, FSSC 22000.

Applications for this new program are now accessible at ANAB's website via the normal process. Program requirements are defined in ANAB Accreditation Rule 39.

FSSC 22000 is a subordinate standard program and applicants shall be accredited by ANAB for ISO 22000 or become accredited concurrently for ISO 22000 and FSSC 22000.

CBs with a provisional license from the Foundation for Food Safety Certification have 2011/07/01 to become accredited.
