Re: Revised ANAB Accreditation Rules 29, 34, and 40

These three Accreditation Rules have been revised as follows for immediate implementation:

Accreditation Rule 29, Accreditation Program for the Aerospace ICOP Program:

- Added AA, MLA, and OEM to abbreviations
- Added IAQG ICOP Resolutions and IAQG OPMT Supplemental Rules to Requirement Documents
- Included resolutions (that will remain requirements in 9104/1);
 - CBs shall be AS9100 accredited for one year before applying for AS9110 or AS9120
 - CBs must wait 12 months to reapply after withdrawal
 - Requirements for suspension
- Added a new requirement that the CB shall manage official complaints, OASIS feedback, nonconformities, and other issues and concerns generated by OEMs or other customers through the CB's nonconformity process, whereby the CB is required to undertake correction, root cause analysis, and corrective action
- Added a comment that ASRP is now allowed for aerospace certified clients

Accreditation Rule 34, Accreditation Program for Responsible Recycling (R2) Certification:

- Updated the source for Responsible Recycling Practices in section 1.1
- Specified that the list of certified organizations must be maintained on the CB's website

Accreditation Rule 40, Accreditation Program Organizational Resilience-Emergency Preparedness-Business Continuity Management Systems:

- Added ASIS/BSI BCM.01 as a program standard
