Re: AS9100 Auditors-Expiration of Certification or Approval

This is to alert all registrars approved for AS9100 that the certification or approval of an auditor will expire after three years unless there is evidence of continuing audits and education in accordance with AIR5359B, 7.3.

For any auditor **certified by RAB**, the evidence of continuing audits and education should be submitted to Lisa Williams of the Registrar Accreditation Board.

For any auditors **approved by ANSI-RAB NAP (but not RAB certified)**, the evidence of continuing audits and education should be submitted to me at rdougherty@rabnet.com

Note 1: For any AIEA or AEA who does not have his or her expiration date extended following review of evidence of continuing audits and education, the OASIS database will consider the approval expired and will not accept entry of audits by these auditors.

Note 2: Because registrars were first approved in May 2001, this requirement is just becoming applicable.
